

# Crochet Pink Tentacle Sea Anemone II (Pink Peppermint & Vanilla Peppermint Glow)

## **Pink Tentacle Sea Anemone glows in the dark!**

Create the amigurumi Anemone in one piece with two sections: the cylinder column base and tentacle top. The tentacles are outlined in a 2nd color with a single crochet for a glowing effect. Any two colors of Fine Jelly Yarn can be used for the color combinations. Jelly Yarn glow in the dark colors: Pink Peppermint Glow, Vanilla Peppermint Glow and Green Peppermint Glow

### Notes:

- 1) Metal hooks recommended.
- 2) Use vinyl protectant (i.e. Vinylex) or thick hand lotion to help stitches glide.
- 3) To help keep the sides straight, gently stuff cylinder with bubble wrap, plastic bag, or fabric.
- 4) Crochet cylinder in a counter-clockwise spiral direction working the Wrong Side out. I prefer to work Wrong side out, then turn the piece Right Side out when finished. See How to crochet Wrong Side out Counter-clockwise: <http://www.craftydeb.com/tutorial01>

### Yarn

Jelly Yarn 100% vinyl / 85yds / 78m ([www.jellyyarns.com](http://www.jellyyarns.com))  
Color A: Pink Peppermint Glow Jelly Yarn Fine (partial ball)  
Color B: Vanilla Peppermint Glow Jelly Yarn Fine (partial ball)

### Hooks


H/8 (5mm), G/6 (4mm), F/5 (3.75mm) METAL hooks

### Stitch Patterns Used

Single Crochet  
Double Crochet

### Abbreviations:

ch: chain  
dc: double crochet  
cm: centimeter  
rnd: round  
sc: single crochet  
sl st: slip stitch  
st/sts: stitch (stitches)  
RS: right side  
WS: wrong side



## Tentacle Sea Anemone Pattern

### Cylinder

With A yarn and H hook, ch 26, straighten chain, join to 1st ch with sl st to form ring. Place stitch marker and move up after each round.

*Note: Work (WS) out by crocheting cylinder in counter-clockwise direction. (See Note 4.)*

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch around, do not turn. (25 sts)

**Rnd 2:** Sc in each st around.

Repeat Rnd 2 working in a spiral around marker, forming the cylinder until height measures 1.5 inches (3.8cm).

*Change to G hook.*

Repeat Rnd 2 working in a counter-clockwise spiral around marker, forming the cylinder until the height measures a total of 3.5 inches (6.35cm).

Do not fasten off.

*Note: Block by stuffing the cylinder overnight, to help keep the sides straight. Gently stuff cylinder with bubble wrap, plastic bag or fabric to hold shape.*

Turn Right Side out. (See Note #4.)

### Tentacle Top

Change to B yarn. *Note: Tie a square knot to join JY yarn colors.*

**Tentacle:** \*With G hook, ch 15. Change to F hook, turn, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, dc in each ch across. (2 sc and 12 dc)

Ch 1, skip 1 st on cylinder, sc in next sc on cylinder.\*

Repeat from \* to \* around for each tentacle. (13 tentacles)

Join with sl st to last sc on cylinder.

Fasten off and tie a double knot.

*Change to B yarn and F hook.*

**2nd color around Tentacle:** Begin at base of tentacle, \*sc in first dc of tentacle, and in each of the next 11 dc, sc in each of the next 2 sc, ch 1 at tip, sc in each top loop along the opposite edge of the tentacle, ch 1.

Repeat from \* around for each tentacle. (13 tentacles)

Fasten off and tie a double knot. Leave 12 inches (30.5cm) for sewing.

### Finishing

Thread large needle with remaining strand. a) Weave needle in and out of spaces under tentacles.

b) Pull yarn tight to gather top then make a tight double knot.

Weave ends on inside of cylinder and tie a double knot to an inside loop. Trim ends.

Fold bottom edge of cylinder up about 1/2 inch (1.25cm) and sew around.
